


Jagannatha means Lord of the Universe, referring to Krishna, and the english word juggernaut - meaning a large truck or vehicle, originates from the name of this festival.

The deities of Lord Jagannatha, Lord Balarama and Lady Subhadra ride on three enormous chariots or Raths, which are pulled through the streets by thousands of pilgrims, Londoners and tourists. Admission is free and everyone is welcome to participate.

Among the attractions at Trafalgar Square there will be Drama, Dancing, Musical performances, Exhibitions on the Vedic Culture of India, and a Mantra Meditation workshop.

A Free Vegetarian Feast will be served during the afternoon.
